


### THE MAJORITY WORLD, FAST FACTS:

- Refers to the countries that are home to the majority of the world's people with roughly 85% of the world's population living in the Majority World
- Africa will account for over half of global population growth between now and 2050
- Despite being home to most of humanity, only 10% of the world's wealth is controlled by the Majority World
- It's made up of 140 countries

#### 5 FACTS ABOUT HOW THE WORLD'S POPULATION IS EXPECTED TO CHANGE BY 2100


- 1. Global population growth is expected to slow between now and 2100 peaking at 10.3 billion in 2084 and declining to 10.2 by 2100.
- 2. The world's three most populous countries in 2025 are expected to have radically different trajectories in the coming decades:
- India will grow until it peaks around 2061 at 1.7 billion
- China's population will shrink to 633 million from 1.4 billion today
- •U.S. is expected to grow steadily to 410 million by 2100
- 3. Five countries are expected to contribute more than 60% of the world's population growth by 2100: Democratic Republic of Congo, Ethiopia, Nigeria, Pakistan and Tanzania
- 4. The world's population is expected to get older. The world's median age will rise to 42 by 2100, up from 31 today and 22 in 1950.
- 5. Africa is currently the world's youngest region with the median age of 19, and it's expected to stay that way through to 2100.





The recent rise of female presidents and prime ministers in Mexico, Nepal, and India reflects a broader progressive shift toward gender equity in political leadership, signaling growing recognition of women's capability to shape national and global futures.





BRAZILIAN ARTIST FÁBIO GOMES TRINDADE MASTERFULLY MELDS THE REALMS OF URBAN LANDSCAPES AND NATURAL ELEMENTS IN HIS STRIKING MURALS THAT BRING THESE TWO WORLDS TOGETHER IN A HARMONIOUS BLEND. BY INTEGRATING TREES AND FOLIAGE AS CONTINUATIONS OF THE HUMAN HAIR IN HIS PORTRAITS, TRINDADE EFFECTIVELY DISSOLVES THE BOUNDARIES BETWEEN THE NATURAL AND URBAN SPHERES.



AFRICA, which had less than one-tenth of the world's population in 1950, by 2050 willl be home to 3.9 billion people—or, 40% of humanity—and about 40% of all the people under 18 in the world will be African.








THE SCRAMBLE FOR AFRICA WAS THE LATE 19TH-CENTURY RUSH BY EUROPEAN POWERS TO COLONIZE AND CARVE UP NEARLY THE ENTIRE AFRICAN CONTINENT, DRIVEN BY COMPETITION FOR RESOURCES, TERRITORY AND INFLUENCE, WITH LITTLE REGARD FOR THE PEOPLE OR CULTURES ALREADY LIVING THERE. ON TOP OF WHICH AFRICA HAS BEEN UNDERESTIMATED IN SIZE FOR HUNDREDS OF YEARS WHICH THE EQUAL MAP MOVEMENT IS TRYING TO REDRESS.






WE GOT A REALITY CHECK BY AL JAZEERA, REMINDING US THAT AFRICA IS NOT A COUNTRY AS IT IS SO OFTEN MIS-CATEGORIZED. THE CONTINENT IS COMPRISED OF 54 COUNTRIES WITH MORE THAN 2000 DIFFERENT LANGUAGES SPOKEN.

WE LEARNED ABOUT AN INNOVATIVE LAND RECOVERY PROJECT CALLED THE GREAT GREEN WALL OF AFRICA THAT'S HARVESTING RAINWATER, INCREASING FOOD SECURITY, AND REHABILITATING THE ECOSYSTEM FROM ONE COAST TO THE OTHER ACROSS NORTHERN AFRICA. MORE THAN HALF A MILLION PEOPLE ARE NOW SELF-SUSTAINING WITH ENOUGH FOOD AND WATER.
